Priorities for the Next Parliament

- The Canadian Chamber of Commerce has prepared and distributed a document focusing on the needs of business and the "**Priorities for the Next Parliament**", no matter who forms government. They will also be tracking party responses to the items, and follow along with the alignments to business needs through party announcements, etc.
- There are three key "mega-buckets" in which the document shares 37 recommendations for government to consider. The three buckets are:
  - Finishing the Fight Against COVID
  - Getting the Fundamentals Right
  - Creating 21st Century Opportunities

- Many of the recommendations and policy objectives are supported by your local chamber. Things like the Truth and Reconciliation recommendations; modernization of the Tax System in Canada, particularly for SME's.
