Canadian Chamber: Why has the government blocked Parliaments's new law?:

- The Chamber issued a statement regarding the government's decision to stall the implementation of Bill C-208
 - "Parliament has spoken and made its desire clear to make the same of a small business to family members as easy as a sale to an unrelated buyer. Bill C-208 addressed this discriminatory tax policy, only to see the new legislation's implementation blocked."
- The decision to shelve the legislation of Bill C-208 is highly unusual and the government should reverse this decision immediately.
- This is all about tax fairness and succession planning for family businesses.
- The Canadian Chamber is calling for the government to immediately allow the legislation to come into effect.

Canadian Chamber: Jobs begin rebound “honeymoon” phase, but opportunities from labour market churn not yet felt:

- The Chamber issued a statement regarding the recently released jobs numbers.
- The job numbers matched a widely expected rebound as lockdown restrictions continued to ease in key labour markets. The rebound phase could last well into the fall as vaccination percentages rise and restrictions unwind.
- The Chamber notes that when the shine of the increased numbers wears off, we'll still have a significant labour market gap to address.

Federal Government:

Government Launches Jobs & Growth Fund

- Applications can now be submitted for new fund supporting clean, inclusive recovery and long-term economic growth
- “By investing in our job creators and the organizations that support them, the Jobs and Growth Fund will help to create quality jobs, pursue inclusive and clean growth opportunities, and empower businesses and communities from coast to coast to coast. Our government has a plan to finish the fight against COVID-19—and ensure a resilient economic recovery that creates good jobs and growth for all Canadians. Today’s announcement is an important step forward in getting us there.” (Minister Melanie Joly)

Minister Carr Announces Shop Local Investment:

- The investment of up to \$7.2 million will be going to Manitoba, Saskatchewan and Alberta to encourage people to shop locally and support businesses in their community as they reopen. This will help businesses stay open so they can thrive as the economy recovers.
- This is part of a national investment of \$33 million to support Shop Local campaigns across the country announced by the Honourable Mary Ng, Minister of Small Business, Export Promotion and International Trade, on June 21.

Lifting of the State of Emergency in Saskatchewan.

Lifting of the emergency health measures in the province brings more than just relief.

It also means an end to emergency layoffs.

Employers will have two weeks within which to schedule an employee who has been on a temporary layoff back to work, or provide pay instead of notice as required by The Employment Standards Regulations.
